A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 4(a) of the *Visiting Forces Act*, Cap. 118 it is provided that the Governor-General may by proclamation designate any country as a designated state for the purposes of the said Act:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the United States of America should be designated as a designated state for the purposes of the said Act:

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power and authority in me vested, I do hereby designate the United States of America as a designated state for the purposes of the said Act, for the perioid 11th April, 2009 to 24th April, 2009, both these dates inclusive.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Barbados this 11th day of April, 2009, and in the fifty-eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
