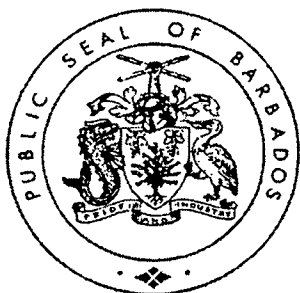

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60(1) of the *Constitution* that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place and commence at such time as the Governor-General may appoint:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that a session of Parliament shall be held at the Parliament Buildings, Bridgetown, commencing on the 6th March, 2013:

NOW THEREFORE by virtue and in exercise of the power and authority in me vested I, Sir Elliott Fitzroy Belgrave, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight of St. Andrew, Governor-General of Barbados, **DO HEREBY APPOINT** the Parliament Buildings, Bridgetown, as the place at which a session of Parliament shall be held at 4 o'clock in the afternoon of 6th March, 2013, as the time at which the said session shall commence.
