**Public Officers Loan and Travelling Allowances Act  
Cap. 31**

**PUBLIC OFFICERS LOAN AND TRAVELLING  
ALLOWANCES (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 2009**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the *Public Officers Loan and Travelling Allowances Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Public Officers Loan and Travelling Allowances (Amendment) Regulations, 2009*.

2. The *Public Officers Loan and Travelling Allowances Regulations, 2001*, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations, are amended by deleting regulation 14 and substituting the following:

14. Notwithstanding regulation 13,

(a) an officer specified in the *Fifth Schedule* is entitled to a commuted travelling allowance at the rate of

(i) \$932.80 per month with effect from 1st April, 2008; and

(ii) \$974.78 per month with effect from 1st April, 2009;

(b) an officer specified in the *Sixth Schedule* is entitled to a commuted travelling allowance at the rate of

(i) \$583.00 per month with effect from 1st April, 2008; and

- (ii) \$609.24 per month with effect from 1st April, 2009.”.

- (d) in paragraph 31 under the heading “Health Service”, by

- (ii) adding the following sub-heading and offices immediately after the words “Director”;

- (e) in paragraph 34 under the heading “Hospitals”, by inserting the following office under the sub-heading “(a) *Psychiatric Hospital*” in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Works Supervisor”;

- (f) in paragraph 41 under the heading “Labour”, by inserting the following offices under the sub-heading “(b) *Labour Department*” in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Legal Officer”;

- (g) in paragraph 48 under the heading “National Insurance Department”, by inserting the following office in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Chief Information Technology Officer”;

- (h) in paragraph 60 under the heading “Public Works and Transport”, by inserting the following offices under the sub-heading “(a) *General*” in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Internal Auditor  
Senior Internal Auditor”;

- (i) in paragraph 69 under the heading “Treasury Department”, by inserting the following offices in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“Internal Auditor  
Senior Internal Auditor”.

- Schedule. 4. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the Second Schedule and substituting therefor the *Schedule* to these Regulations.

For every additional kilometre travelled each month	\$0.84 per kilometre	\$0.88 per kilometre
For each passenger transported	\$0.08 per kilometre	\$0.09 per kilometre

PART B

*Motor Cycles*

<i>Distance</i>	<i>Rate From 1st April, 2008</i>	<i>Rate From 1st April, 2009</i>
For the first 320 kilometres travelled each month	\$0.74 per kilometre	\$0.78 per kilometre
For every additional kilometre travelled each month	\$0.27 per kilometre	\$0.28 per kilometre.”.
