ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Public Transport (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2020.*

2. *Transport Authority Act*, Cap. 295A - (Cont'd) (2) The Authority may suspend the permit of the owner or operator of vehicle who is subsequently convicted pursuant to section 27(2)(b).".

Insert immediately after section 24, the following:

"Appointment of stands for public service vehicles

24A. The Transport Authority may, subject to the approval of the Minister and by notice published in the *Official Gazette*, designate stands and parking places for use exclusively by public service vehicles plying or standing for hire, and inform the Commissioner of Police accordingly in writing.".

Delete section 27 and substitute the following:

"Special offences in respect of public service vehicles

27. (1) Any person who drives or conducts a public service vehicle in respect of which there is not in existance a valid permit issued under this Act is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction,

- (a) in the case of a first conviction, to a fine of \$1 000; and
- (b) in the case of a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine of \$2 000.

(2) Any owner or operator of a vehicle who uses or permits a vehicle to be used as a public service vehicle

- (b) in Form F, delete the words "Motor Omnibus No." and the words "Public Service Vehicle No.".

In Part I of the Fifth Schedule,

(a) delete paragraph 5 and all the words appearing opposite thereto in the columns marked "Description of Examination" and "Amount of Fees" respectively; Schedule - (Concl'd)

In the Eleventh Schedule,

- (a) delete paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 and all the words appearing opposite thereto in the columns marked "Description" and "Amount of Fees" respectively;
- (b) in paragraph 4(1), delete sub-subparagraphs (e), (f) and (g) and all of the words appearing opposite thereto in the columns marked "Description" and "Amount of Fees" respectively; and
- (c) in paragraph 4(2) delete all of the words appearing in the column marked "Description" and substitute the words "Duplicate licence for classes (a) to (d)".
