- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the *Representation of the People (Expenses) Regulations, 1990.*
- **2.** The following are the rates of remuneration payable to a registering officer, an official photographer, and an enumerator in respect of their services under the *Representation of the People* 1990/8. (*Registration of Electors*) *Regulations*, 1990:
 - (a) Registering Officer \$32 275.28 per annum x \$879.14 2007/134. in an annual incremental scale to \$37 550.09 with effect from 1st April, 2006;
 - (b) Enumerator 1996/20.
 - (i) \$1.50 in respect of each application for registration completed by him;
 - (ii) \$0.50 in respect of each deletion from the Register; 1996/20.
 - (c) Official Photographer \$33 082.08 per annum x \$901.08 2007/134. in an annual incremental scale to \$38 488.56 with effect from 1st April, 2007.

2008/14. **3.** The following are the rates of remuneration payable to election officers in respect of their services at an election:

Returning Officer - \$4 375.00 Election Clerk - \$3 281.25 Presiding Officer - \$1 093.75 Special Presiding Officer - \$1 093.75 Poll Clerk - \$787.50 Counting Assistant - \$787.50.

4. In addition to the remuneration specified in Regulation 2, a Registering Officer shall be paid a travelling allowance at a rate of

- (a) \$626.46 per month from 1st April, 2006 to 31st March, 2007; and
- (b) \$642.12 per month from 1st April, 2007.
- **5.** In respect of their travelling expenses in connection with an election, a Returning Officer and an Election Clerk shall be paid travelling allowance at the rates payable to public officers under the *Public Officers Loan and Travelling Allowances Regulations*, 2001.
