REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (IDENTIFICATION CARDS REPLACEMENT FEE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2009

The Electoral and Boundaries Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 68(1)(e) of the Representation of the People Act, makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the People (Identification Cards Replacement Fee) (Amendment) Regulations, 2009.
- 2. Regulation 2 of the Representation of the People S.I. 2007 (Identification Cards Replacement Fee) Regulations, 2007 is amended No. 10. by
 - (a) deleting paragraph (2) and substituting the following:
 - "(2) The following persons are exempt from the fee payable under paragraph (1):
 - (a) a person who is 65 years of age or over; and
 - (b) a person who is in the care and custody of a public institution where the person in charge of that institution
 - (i) issues a certificate to that effect; and
 - (ii) requests the replacement of the identification card of that person; and

- (c) a disabled person who is not in the care and custody of a public institution where the Director of the National Disabilities Unit
 - (i) issues a certificate to that effect; and
 - (ii) requests the replacement of the identification card of the disabled person."; and
- (b) inserting immediately after paragraph (2) the following:
 - "(3) In these Regulations, "public institution" includes the following:
 - (a) Government Children's Homes;
 - (b) the Geriatric Hospital;
 - (c) Psychiatric Hospital;
 - (d) District Hospitals; and
 - (e) the Welfare Department.".
