**REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (IDENTIFICATION  
CARDS REPLACEMENT FEE) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 2009**

The Electoral and Boundaries Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 68(1)(e) of the *Representation of the People Act*, makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Representation of the People (Identification Cards Replacement Fee) (Amendment) Regulations, 2009*.

2. Regulation 2 of the *Representation of the People (Identification Cards Replacement Fee) Regulations, 2007* is amended by

(a) deleting paragraph (2) and substituting the following:

“(2) The following persons are exempt from the fee payable under paragraph (1):

(a) a person who is 65 years of age or over; and

(b) a person who is in the care and custody of a public institution where the person in charge of that institution

(i) issues a certificate to that effect; and

(ii) requests the replacement of the identification card of that person; and

- (c) a disabled person who is not in the care and custody of a public institution where the Director of the National Disabilities Unit
  - (i) issues a certificate to that effect; and
  - (ii) requests the replacement of the identification card of the disabled person.”; and
- (b) inserting immediately after paragraph (2) the following:
  - “(3) In these Regulations, “public institution” includes the following:
    - (a) Government Children’s Homes;
    - (b) the Geriatric Hospital;
    - (c) Psychiatric Hospital;
    - (d) District Hospitals; and
    - (e) the Welfare Department.”.
