**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Association of Dragsters and Drifters "Speed Trials") Directions, 2013*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday September 22, 2013

(a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Philip, the section of road known as Thicketts Supers road commencing from the junction with Stewart Hill, proceeding in a south easterly direction along the said Thicketts Supers road and finishing at the junction with Thicketts main road (Highway 4B).

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
