**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club "All Stage Rally") Directions, 2012*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, May 6, 2012

(a) Between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Society commencing at its junction with Society Hill proceeding in a north easterly direction along Colleton in a southerly direction along Roebuck Street and finishing at the junction of Roebuck Street and Pool.

(b) In the parishes of Saint John and Saint Joseph from that section of road at the junction of Blackman and Branchbury in a northerly direction past Bonwell turning in an easterly direction along McColitt Bridge Road continuing in an easterly direction along Easy Hall and Malvern Roads and finishing along Malvern Road in the vicinity or Edey's Village.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
