## DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club "All Stage Rally") Directions, 2013.
  - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

## On Sunday April 28, 2013

- (a) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Joseph and Saint Andrew, the section of road known as Lower Parks commencing the junction with Upper Parks, proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Lower Parks road and Dark Hole road, continuing in a northerly direction on Haggatts road, proceeding in a westerly direction on St. Simon's road and finishing at the junction of St. Simon's and Isolation roads.
- (b) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas the section of road known as Hangman's Hill, commencing from the junction with Highway 2 (Hopewell), proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Hangman's Hill, continuing in a northerly direction on Duke's road and Canefield road, proceeding in a westerly and northerly direction on the said Canefield road and finishing at the junction of Canefield road and Blunt's road.

- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
