**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL  
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE  
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD  
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88  
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC  
REGULATIONS, 1984  
AS AMENDED**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club "Speed Event") Directions, 2013*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

**On Saturday August 17, 2013**

(a) Between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas the section of road known as Hangman's Hill, commencing from the junction with Highway 2 (Hopewell), proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Hangman's Hill, continuing in a northerly direction on Duke's road, proceeding in an easterly direction on Lion Castle road and finishing at the junction with Lion Castle Polo Estate.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
