DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "All Stage Rally") Directions, 2010.*

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, November 14, 2010

(a) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Philip and Saint John, the section of road known as Featherbed Lane, commencing from the junction with Halton Road, proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Featherbed Lane, continuing in a northerly direction along Cliff Road, proceeding in a westerly direction along Guinea Road, continuing in a northerly and westerly direction along Ashford Road (Highway 4) and finishing at the junction with Colleton Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
