OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "All Stage Rally") Directions, 2010.
- 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period on Saturday July 24, 2010.
 - (a) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Andrew, the section of road known as Turner's Hall, commencing at its junction with Bawden, proceeding in a south westerly and northerly direction along the said Turner's Hall Road and finishing at the junction with Swann Factory and Rock Hall.
