**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "BRC Winter Rally") Directions, 2017*.
2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday November 25, 2017

- (a) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Joseph, Saint Andrew and Saint Thomas, the section of road being the upper section of St. Sylvan's road (Dark Hole), proceeding in a northerly direction on the said St. Sylvan's road, continuing in a southerly direction on Bruce Vale, Cane Garden, Friendship, Spring Vale and Chapman's Village roads and finishing at the junction of Chapman's Village and Sturges roads.
- (b) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Hangman's Hill, commencing from the junction with Highway 2 (Hopewell), proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Hangman's Hill, continuing in a northerly direction on Dukes road, proceeding in an easterly direction on Lion Castle road and finishing at the junction with Lion Castle Polo Estate.

- (c) Between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and 11.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter the section of road French Village road, commencing from the junction with Applegrove proceeding in a south easterly and southerly direction on the said French Village road, continuing in a westerly direction on Orange Hill road, proceeding in a south easterly direction on Four Hill road and finishing at the junction of Four Hill and Indian Ground roads.
- (d) Between the hours of 6.00 p.m. and 11.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Dukes road, commencing from the junction with Canefield road, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Dukes road, continuing in an easterly, westerly and southerly direction on Hangman's Hill, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Hangman's Hill and finishing at the junction with Hopewell road (Highway 2).

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
