**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "BRC Winter Rally") Directions, 2019*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday October 27, 2019

- (a) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Joseph, Saint Andrew and Saint Thomas, the section of road being the upper section of St. Sylvan's road (Dark Hole), proceeding in a northerly direction on the said St. Sylvan's road, continuing in a southerly direction on Bruce Vale, Cane Garden, Friendship, Spring Vale and Chapman's Village roads and finishing at the junction of Chapman's Village and Sturges roads.
- (b) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Lion Castle road up to the junction with Lion Castle Polo Estate. Also in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Dukes road, commencing from the junction with Canefield road, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Dukes road, continuing in an easterly, westerly and southerly direction on Hangman's Hill, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Hangman's Hill and finishing at the junction with Hopewell road (Highway 2).

(c) Between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Andrew and Saint James, the section of road known as Swann road, commencing from the junction with Bawden road, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Swann road, continuing in a south westerly and southerly direction on Turner's Hall road, proceeding in a westerly direction on Mose Bottom road, continuing in a southerly direction on Gregg Farm and Apes Hill roads and finishing at the junction with Orange Hill road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
