**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Mud Fest Event") Directions, 2009*.

2. The following road will accommodate traffic only in an easterly direction during the specified period:

On Sunday, August 23, 2009

(a) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Pot House Hill commencing from the junction with Highway 3B (Glebe Land), proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Pot House Hill and finishing at the junction with Welch Town Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
