DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Speed Event") Directions, 2016.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday October 2, 2016

- (a) Between the hours of 11.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Lucy, the section of road known as Church Hill road, commencing from the junction immediately east of St. Lucy Parish Church, proceeding in an easterly direction through Mount Gilboa and Mount Gay before turning south and proceeding towards Oxford Plantation and finishing at the junction of Luke Hill road and Charles Duncan O'Neale Highway.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
