DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Speed Event") Directions, 2017.*
- 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period on Sunday October 8, 2017.
 - (a) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Lucy, the section of road known as Highway 2B commencing at its junction with Collins road, proceeding in a westerly direction along the said Highway 2B pass Lamberts Plantation, continuing in a south westerly direction on Lamberts road to the junction at Alexandra, proceeding in a northerly direction on Josey Hill and finishing at the junction with Mount View road.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
