DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Speed Trials") Directions, 2018.*
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday October 28, 2018.

- (a) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 6.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Philip and Saint John, the section of road known as Mapps road commencing from the junction with Fairfield road, proceeding in a north easterly and northerly direction on the said Mapps road, continuing in a northerly and north westerly direction on Three Houses and Supers roads, proceeding in a northerly direction on Thicketts road, continuing in a northerly and north westerly direction on Stewart Hill and finishing at the junction with Massiah Street.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
