DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Speed Trials") Directions, 2010.*
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, October 31, 2010

- (a) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, commencing on the section of road known as Featherbed Lane heading in a Northerly direction on to Cliff Road in a Westerly direction on to Highway 4 along Guinea Road on to Highway "4A" past Ashford and Victoria Plantations to finish before the junction of Highway "H" in the vicinity of Colleton Plantation.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
