**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL  
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE  
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD  
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88  
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC  
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "Speed Trials") Directions, 2010*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

**On Sunday, October 31, 2010**

(a) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, commencing on the section of road known as Featherbed Lane heading in a Northerly direction on to Cliff Road in a Westerly direction on to Highway 4 along Guinea Road on to Highway "4A" past Ashford and Victoria Plantations to finish before the junction of Highway "H" in the vicinity of Colleton Plantation.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
