ROAD TRAFFIC (CAR PARKS) REGULATIONS, 2000

Authority: These Regulations were made on 13th March, 2000 by the Minister under section 124(1)(l) of the *Road Traffic Act*.

Commencement: 23rd March, 2000.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Car Parks) Regulations, 2000.*

2. The places named in the first column of Part I of the *Schedule*, schedule. as respectively described in the second column of the *Schedule*, are appointed as parking places for the parking of private or rented motor cars.

3. The charges specified in Part II of the *Schedule* are payable in _{Schedule}. respect of the parking of a motor car in a parking place.

1. Independence Square Car Park	The area of land bounded on the north by the Careenage, on the east by Bridge Street, on the south by Lower Fairchild Street and on the west by Lower Bay Street.
2. Carlisle Car Park	The area of land bounded on the north by Hincks Street, on the east by McGregor Street on the south by the Wharf Road and on the west by Canary Street.
3. Coleridge Street Car Park	The area of land bounded on the north by Pinfold Street, on the east by lands of the Jewish Synagogue and Codds House on the south by Upper James Street and on the west by Coleridge Street.
4. Lower Wharf Car Park	The area of land bounded on the north by lands of the Crown and the Insurance Corporation of Barbados, by Cowell Street, by lands of S. P. Musson & Sons, by Prince Alfred Street and by lands of Fortress Caribbean Property, to the east by the Lower Wharf Road, to the south by the sea and Crown lands and to the west by Crown lands.
5. Princess Alice Car Park	The area of land bounded on the north by Temple Yard and by Drum Street, on the east by Cumberland Street on the south by the Princess Alice Highway and on the west by Drum Street.
