**ROAD TRAFFIC (FEE FOR DRIVING LICENCE AND
LEARNER'S PERMIT) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER, 2010**

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 63(2) and 76(1) of the *Road Traffic Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Fee for Driving Licence and Learner's Permit) (Amendment) Order, 2010*.

2. The *Road Traffic (Fee for Driving Licence and Learner's Permit) Order, 1985* is amended by inserting immediately after paragraph 4 the following as paragraph 5: S.I. 1985
No. 44.

“5. (1) Notwithstanding paragraph 4

(a) the fee payable by a person

- (i) 65 years or older in respect of a driving licence for one year is \$25;
- (ii) 66 years in respect of a driving licence for four years is \$100;
- (iii) 67 years in respect of a driving licence for three years is \$75;
- (iv) 68 years in respect of a driving licence for two years is \$50;
- (v) 69 years in respect of a driving licence is \$25;

- (b) a person 65 years may renew a driving licence for any period between one year and five years at a fee of \$25 per year;
- (c) a person 66 years may renew a driving licence for any period between one year and four years at a fee of \$25 per year;
- (d) a person 67 years may renew a driving licence for any period between one year and three years at a fee of \$25 per year;
- (e) a person 68 years may renew a driving licence for any period between one year and two years at a fee of \$25 per year;
- (f) a person 69 years may renew a driving licence for only one year at a fee of \$25.”.
