## Road Traffic Act Cap. 295

## ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR VEHICLES (INTERNATIONAL CIRCULATION)) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2009

The Cabinet, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 80 of the *Road Traffic Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles (International Circulation)) (Amendment) Order, 2009.* 

**2.** Paragraph 4 of the *Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles* L.N. 1960/ (*International Circulation*)) Order, 1960 is amended by deleting sub-

"(2) This paragraph shall not authorise a person to drive in Barbados unless he

- (a) is at least 18 years of age;
- (b) has first registered with the Licensing Authority, the Commissioner or an authorised operator of a hired car service; and
- (c) has paid a registration fee of
  - (i) \$10.00 where his temporary stay is less than 2 months; or
  - (ii) \$100.00 where his temporary stay is 2 months or more, but not more than 1 year.".
