**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Rally of the Sun and Stars") Directions, 2009*.
2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday September 12, 2009

- (a) Between the hours of 11.45 a.m. and 5.45 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Hangman's Hill commencing from the junction with Highway 2, proceeding in a westerly direction pass Dukes, Canefield and Mount Misery and finishing at the junction north of Dunscombe.
- (b) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Andrew, the section of road known as Belleplaine Road, commencing from the junction with Isolation Road, proceeding in a southerly direction along the said Belleplaine Road, continuing in a southerly direction on Dark Hole Road (St. Sylvan's Road) continuing in a south easterly direction on Upper Parks Road and ending at the junction of Upper Parks and Fruitful Hill Road.
- (c) Between the hours of 6.45 p.m. and 9.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Joseph and Saint John, the section of road known as Gutter Road, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Gutter Road, continuing in a north easterly direction on Claybury and Redland Roads, proceeding in a northerly direction on Wilson Hill road and Easy Hall road , in an easterly direction on the said Easy Hall road, Malvern road and Edgecliff road and finishing at the junction with Sherbourne and Clifton Hall.

(d) Between the hours of 7.15 p.m. and 9.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Ashford commencing from the Colleton/Ashford junction, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Ashford road, continuing in a westerly direction on Bowmanston road, proceeding in a northerly direction on the Roebuck Street road and finishing at the junction with Highway 3B (Pool).

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given a by member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
