DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Rally of the Sun and Stars") Directions, 2012.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday September 8, 2012

- (a) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 12.00 midnight in the parishes of Saint Philip and Saint John, the sections of road known as Mapps, commencing from the junction with Bushy Park, proceeding in a northerly direction pass Three Houses and Thicketts, continuing in an easterly direction to the junction at Stewart Hill, proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Stewart Hill and finishing at the junction with Massiah Street.
- (b) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 12.00 midnight in the parishes of Saint Joseph and Saint John, the sections of road known as Gutter Road, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Gutter Road, continuing in a north easterly direction on Claybury and Redland Roads, proceeding in a northerly direction on Wilson Hill and Easy Hall Road, in an easterly direction on the said Easy Hall Road, Malvern Road and Edgecliff Road and finishing at the junction with Sherbourne and Clifton Hall Roads.

- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
