**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Rally of the Sun and Stars") Directions, 2013*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday September 14, 2013

- (a) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 11.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter the section of road known as Diamond Corner, commencing from the junction with Moore Hill, proceeding in a northerly direction along the said Diamond Corner road, continuing in an easterly direction along Castle and Gays roads and finishing at the junction with Mount road No. 2.
- (b) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 11.30 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Peter and Saint Lucy, the section of road known as Alexandra, commencing from the junction with Collins and Date Tree Hill, proceeding in a westerly direction the said Alexandra road and on Lamberts road, continuing in a northwesterly direction along Cottage road and finishing at the junction with Pickering and Half Acre roads.
- (c) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 11.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter, the section or road known as Orange Hill (Sailor Gully), commencing from the junction with Ronald Mapp Highway, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Orange Hill road, continuing in a northerly direction on Prospect road and finishing at the junction with Welchtown road.

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
