DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Rally of the Sun and Stars") Directions, 2014.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday September 13, 2014

- (a) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 12.00 midnight in the parish of Saint Peter, the section of road known as Prospect road commencing from the junction with Welch Town road, proceeding in an southerly direction on the said Prospect road, continuing in a westerly direction on Orange Hill road (Sailor's Gully), and finishing at the junction of Orange Hill road and Four Hill road.
- (b) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 12.00 midnight in the parish of Saint Peter the section of road known as Diamond Corner road commencing from the junction with Moore Hill, proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Diamond Corner road, continuing in an easterly direction on Castle and Gays roads and finishing at the junction with Mount road No. 2.

- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
