DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Event") Directions, 2010.*

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, April 11, 2010

(a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Andrew, the section of road known as Belleplaine Road, commencing from the junction with Isolation Road, proceeding in a southerly direction along the said Belleplaine Road, continuing in a southerly direction on Dark Hole Road (St. Sylvan's Road), continuing in a south easterly direction on Upper Parks Road and ending at the junction of Upper Parks and Fruitful Hill Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
