DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2009.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, October 4, 2009

- (a) Between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter, the section of road known as Mount Brevitor, proceeding in an easterly direction along French Village Road, continuing in a southerly direction along Orange Hill Road, proceeding in an easterly direction along Four Hill Road and finishing at the junction with Roebuck Road.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
