## DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2009.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

## On Sunday, April 19, 2009

Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Lucy, the section of road known as Luke Hill commencing from its junction with Alleyndale, proceeding in a north easterly direction to the junction with Oxford Road and Mount Gay Road, continuing in a north westerly direction on Mount Gay Road ending at the Mount Gay Refinery Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
