DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2010.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, August 8, 2010

- (a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Joseph and Saint John, the section of road known as Gutter Road proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Gutter Road, continuing in a north easterly direction on Claybury and Redland Roads, proceed in a northerly direction on Wilson Hill Road and Easy Hall Road, in an easterly direction on the said Easy Hall Road, Malvern Road and Edgecliff Road and finishing at the junction with Sherbourne and Clifton Hall Roads.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force. the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
