## DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2010.* 
  - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

## On Sunday, October 3, 2010

- (a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Philip and Saint John, the sections of road known as Mapps, commencing from the junction with Bushy Park Road, proceeding in a northerly direction pass Three Houses and Thickets, continuing in an easterly direction to the junction at Stewart Hill, proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Stewart Hill and finishing at the junction with Massiah Street.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
