DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2012.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday April 15, 2012

- (a) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint George and Saint John, the section of road known as Kendal and Woodland (Highway 4) proceeding in a north easterly direction on to Ashford Road, continuing in an easterly direction on Society Road, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Society Road and the Massiah Street Junction, continuing in a westerly direction on Guinea Road, in a southerly direction on Cliff Road and finishing at the junction of Cliff Road and Featherbed Lane.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- 4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
