DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2012.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday, November 4, 2012

- (a) Between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter, the section of road known as Orange Hill Road, (Sailor Gully), commencing from the junction with Ronald Mapp Highway, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Orange Hill Road (Sailor Gully), continuing in a northerly direction on Prospect Road, and finishing at the junction of Prospect Road and Welchtown Road.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
