DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2013.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday April 14, 2013

- (a) Between the hours of 12.00 noon and 4.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Ashford road commencing at the Colleton/Ashford junction, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Ashford road, continuing in a westerly direction on Bowmanston road, proceeding in a northerly direction on Roebuck Street, and finishing at the Highway 3B (Pool) junction.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
