**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2013*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday June 23, 2013

(a) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Philip and Saint John, the section of road known as Mapps, commencing from its junction with Fairfield and Ruby Roads, proceeding in a northerly direction along Thicketts Road then in a westerly direction along Thicketts Road then in a northerly direction along Supers Road, proceeding in a westerly direction along Stewarts Hill finishing at its junction with Massiah Street.

On Sunday July 28, 2013

(b) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Joseph and Saint Andrew, the section of road known as Isolation commencing from its junction with Belleplaine proceeding in a southerly then easterly direction along Saint Simons Road to its junction with Haggatts Road proceeding in a southerly direction with Haggatts Road to its junction with Dark Hole Road proceeding in a southerly direction along Dark Hole Road finishing at its junction with Upper Parks Road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
