DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2015.*
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday September 27, 2015

- (a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Society road commencing at the junction with College Bottom (Highway F), proceeding in a westerly and a northerly direction on the said Society road, continuing in a southerly direction on Ashford road, proceeding in an easterly direction on Guinea road and continuing in a southerly direction three hundred metres onto Cliff road.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
