DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2016.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday August 14, 2016

- (a) Between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Philip and Saint John, the section of road known as Mapps, commencing from its junction with Fairfield and Ruby Roads, proceeding in a northerly direction along Thicketts Road, continuing in a westerly direction along Supers Road, continuing in a northerly direction along Supers Road, continuing in a westerly direction along Stewarts Hill and finishing at its junction with Massiah Street.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
