## DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2016.* 
  - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

## On Sunday September 11, 2016

- (a) Between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Cherry Grove road, commencing from the junction with Roebuck Street, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Cherry Grove road, continuing in a southerly direction on Ashford road, proceeding in a southerly direction on Kendal and Woodland roads, continuing in a westerly direction on the said Woodland road and finishing at the junction of Woodland and Todds roads.
- (b) Between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint John and Saint Joseph, the section of road known as Wilson Hill, commencing at the junction with Sherbourne and Claybury roads, proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Wilson Hill and passing Easy Hall Plantation, continuing in an easterly direction pass Malvern Plantation and finishing at junction with Malvern road.

- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
