## DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2017.
  - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

## On Sunday August 13, 2017.

- (a) Between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Lucy, the section of road known as Cottage road commencing from the junction with Highway 1C/Pickering road, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Cottage road, continuing in a south westerly direction on Mount Gay road, proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Mount Gay road and finishing at the junction with Church Hill and Nestfield road.
- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
