**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL  
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE  
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD  
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88  
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC  
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2018*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

**On Sunday March 18, 2018.**

(a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint John and Saint George, the section of road known as Todds road commencing from the junction with Four Roads, proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Todds road and on Woodland road, continuing in an easterly direction on Woodland and Kendal roads (Highway 4), proceeding in a northerly direction on Ashford road, continuing in a westerly direction on Cherry Grove road, proceeding in a northerly direction on Roebuck Street road and finishing at the junction with Pool road (Highway 3B).

**On Sunday April 8, 2018.**

(b) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint Lucy and Saint Peter, the section of road known as Cottage road, commencing at the junction with Pickerings road, proceeding in an easterly direction on the said Cottage road, continuing in an easterly direction on Alexandra road, proceeding in a southerly direction on the Baltic road and finishing at junction with Boscobelle road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
