DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2018.*
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday September 22, 2018

- (a) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 10.30 p.m. in the parish of Saint Peter, the section of road known as Prospect road, commencing from its junction with Highway 1C (Welchtown), proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Prospect road, continuing in a westerly direction along Orange Hill road, and finishing at the junction with Four Hill road.
- (b) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Lucy, the section of road known as Cottage road, commencing from the junction with Alexandra and Mount Gay roads, proceeding in a north westerly direction on the said Cottage road, continuing in a northerly direction on Half Acre and Spring Hall roads, proceeding in a north westerly direction on Harris' and Mount Poyer roads, continuing in a northerly direction on Mount Poyer road and finishing at the junction with Greenidges and Bright Hall roads.

- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
