DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2019.
 - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday September 21, 2019

- (a) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Cherry Grove road, commencing from its junction with Four Roads/Todds, proceeding in an easterly and north easterly direction along the said Cherry Grove road, continuing in a northerly direction on Ashford road, proceeding in a southerly direction on Society road and finishing at the junction with Codrington Hill.
- (b) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint John, the section of road known as Tappy Pond road, commencing from the junction with Natty Brown Hill, proceeding in a northerly direction along the said Tappy Pond road, continuing in a northerly direction on Claybury road, proceeding in an easterly direction on Wilson Hill, continuing in a northerly direction on Easy Hall road, proceeding in a north easterly direction on Cotton Tower road and finishing at the junction with Blackman's road.

- 3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.
- **4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
