## DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, 1984

- 1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Motoring Club Barbados, Inc. "Speed Trials") Directions, 2019.* 
  - 2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

## On Sunday April 28, 2019

- (a) Between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Mangrove Pondroad, commencing from its junction with Highway 2A (Arch Hall), proceeding in an easterly and north easterly direction along the said Mangrove Pondroad, continuing in a northerly direction on Dukes road (Highway D), proceeding in an easterly direction on Dukes Tenantry road, continuing in a northerly direction on Dukes road, proceeding in a westerly direction on Fortress Hill and finishing at the junction of Fortress Hill and Content road (Highway D).
- **3.** Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

**4.** These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
