**ROAD TRAFFIC (ROAD TAX, REGISTRATION
FEE AND PERMITS) ORDER, 1982**

Authority: This Order was made on 15th June, 1982, by the Minister of Finance under sections 5, 15, 17, 18(3)(a) and (4)(a), 30 and 104(3) of the *Road Traffic Act*.

Commencement: 15th June, 1982.

1. This Order may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Road Tax, Registration Fee and Permits) Order, 1982*.

2. For the purposes of sections 5 and 18(3)(a) and (4)(a) of the Act, the fee payable in respect of the registration of a motor vehicle is \$1.

3. For the purposes of sections 15, 17 and 30 of the Act, the several categories of vehicles set out in Part I and Part IA of the *Schedule* are to be taxed at the appropriate rates specified therein.

4. For the purposes of section 104(3) of the Act, the fee set out in the third column of Part II of the *Schedule* is payable in respect of the issue of a permit for the use of a motor vehicle as a public service vehicle.
