**ROAD TRAFFIC (SPRING GARDEN
HIGHWAY) REGULATIONS, 1983**

1983/172.

Authority: These regulations were made on 11th November, 1983 by the Minister under section 124(1) of the *Road Traffic Act*.

Commencement: 11th November, 1983.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Spring Garden Highway) Regulations, 1983*.

2. In these regulations "Spring Garden Highway" means that Highway that commences at the junction of Holborn Circle, Fontabelle to the South and ends at the junction of Highway 1 and the University Drive to the North.

3. No driver or other person in charge of a vehicle shall cause or permit that vehicle to stop or wait on the Spring Garden Highway.

4. No person shall

(a) drive, ride or propel a vehicle, other than a motor vehicle,

(b) lead an animal drawn vehicle, or

(c) travel by means of skates,

on Spring Garden Highway.

5. No person shall sell, offer for sale or otherwise dispose of any goods, articles or merchandise on the Spring Garden Highway.

6. Any person who contravenes these regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 6 months.
