**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Vaucluse Raceway Motor Sport Club Inc. Rally) Directions, 2019*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Sunday November 17, 2019

(a) Between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Thomas, the section of road known as Hangman's Hill, commencing from the junction with Hopewell road (Highway 2), proceeding in a westerly direction on the said Hangman's Hill, continuing in a northerly direction on Dukes road and finishing at the junction with Lion Castle road.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
