**DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY THE CHIEF TECHNICAL
OFFICER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR ROAD
TRAFFIC UNDER REGULATION 88
OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS, 1984**

1. These directions may be cited as the *Road Traffic (Barbados Rally Club, "BRC Winter Rally") Directions, 2018*.

2. The following roads will be closed during the specified period:

On Saturday November 24, 2018.

- (a) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. in the parishes of Saint George and Saint John, the section of road known as Mount road commencing from the junction with Byre road, proceeding in a northerly direction on the said Mount road, continuing in an easterly direction on Kendal and Woodland roads, proceeding in a northerly direction on Ashford road, continuing in a westerly direction on Cherry Grove road, proceeding in a northerly direction on Roebuck Street road and finishing at the junction with Pool road (Highway 3B).
- (b) Between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. in the parish of Saint Philip, the section of road known as Sunbury road, commencing from the junction with Church Village road proceeding in a southerly direction on the said Sunbury road, continuing in a north easterly direction on Harrow road, proceeding in a southerly direction on Bushy Park road and finishing at the junction with Beulah and Congo roads.

3. Any person who contravenes these directions or fails to comply with the orders given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment for a term of six (6) months.

4. These rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Fire Service or any Ambulance Service.
