SANITATION SERVICE AUTHORITY (FEES) REGULATIONS, 1971

1971/33. 1996/53.

Authority: These Regulations were made on 24th February, 1975 by the Minister under section 6 of the *Sanitation Service Authority Act*.

Commencement: 24th February, 1975.

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the *Sanitation Service Authority (Fees) Regulations*, 1975.
- **2.** (1) The fees payable to the Authority for the removal of rubbish shall be as specified in the *Schedule*. Schedule.
- (2) For the purposes of these Regulations, "load" means a load of 10 cubic yards.
- **3.** Any fees charged under regulation 2 may be recovered as a debt due to the Crown in civil proceedings before a magistrate for District A.

SCHEDULE

1996-53. PART I

For the removal of

- (a) mould from excavated foundations or elsewhere, a fee of \$1.50 per cubic yard or part thereof or \$15 per load;
- (b) the rubbish of any trade or business, or from construction sites, a fee of \$1 per cubic yard or part thereof or \$10 per load;
- (c) ordinary household or domestic rubbish, a fee of \$1 per cubic yard; provided that 2 cubic yards of such rubbish shall be removed free of charge from each household at each daily collection;
- (d) any other rubbish, a fee of \$9 per load.

1996-53. PART II

For the deposit and disposal of refuse at any refuse disposal site, \$25 per tonne or part thereof.
